BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Montvale, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. \$40,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund is hereby appropriated to fund the procurement of municipal management hardware and software for the Borough of Montvale.

SECTION 2. The Borough hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication and otherwise as provided by law.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONTVALE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 385 OF THE BOROUGH CODE TO DESIGNATE TWO STOP INTERSECTIONS AND REMOVE ONE YIELD INTERSECTION

WHEREAS, the intersection of Kinderkamack Road and Magnolia Avenue has been the location of a number of accidents in recent years; and

WHEREAS, the County of Bergen did conduct a study to determine how to improve traffic safety at this intersection; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer did also conduct a study to determine whether "Stop" signs would be warranted for all cars entering Kinderkamack Road either southbound or eastbound off Magnolia Avenue; and

WHEREAS, it was recommended that the Borough adopt an ordinance designating the intersection of Magnolia Avenue and Kinderkamack as a "Stop" intersection either southbound or eastbound off Magnolia Avenue; and

WHEREAS, because this area is under the jurisdiction of the County of Bergen, the County must concur with the Borough's request to place "Stop" signage at the relevant intersection; and

WHEREAS, the County has indicated that it does concur with this request and will install the necessary signage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Montvale as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 385, Section 41, is hereby amended and supplemented by adding the following two intersections to Schedule VIII – Stop Intersections," as follows:

§385-41 Schedule VIII – Stop Intersections.

Intersection	Stop Sign On
Magnolia Avenue and Kinderkamack Road	Magnolia Avenue, southbound
Magnolia Avenue and Kinderkamack road	Magnolia Avenue, eastbound

Section 2. Chapter 385, Section 42, is hereby amended by removing the following intersection from "Schedule IX – Yield Intersections," as follows:

§385-42 Schedule IX – Yield Intersections.

Intersection	Yield Sign On
Kinderkamack Road and Magnolia Avenue	Magnolia Avenue

Section 3. Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed only to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

Section 4. Savings Clause.

Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed pursuant to this Ordinance, nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 5. Severability.

The various parts, sections and clauses of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, paragraph, section or clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and publication as required by law.

1. The Borough of Montvale does approve Quote #170076 from Yorktel for the purchase of GovPilot Municipal Management Computer Software in the amount of \$36,363.00 annually, plus a \$3,000 one-time fee for data integration.





Whereas, Maser Consulting did previously conduct an Area Traffic Study for the Village of Chestnut Ridge dated December 29, 2020, and revised on February 3, 2021, concerning the Red Schoolhouse Road corridor; and

Whereas, Red Schoolhouse Road turns into Spring Valley Road at the NJ/NY border, and the traffic on said road has a significant impact on residents of Montvale and the County of Bergen; and

Whereas, the Area Traffic Study contained a number of recommendations for roadway improvements necessitated by the anticipated development on the Red Schoolhouse Road corridor; and

Whereas, included in that analysis was the assumed use of certain real property known as the "Triangle Properties," for which a retail shopping center of approximately 137,500 square feet was then proposed; and

Whereas, the proposed use for the Triangle Properties now consists of a warehouse/distribution center that would generate significant heavy truck traffic along the Red Schoolhouse Road and Spring Valley Road corridor, which would have significant impact on those and other roads in the area as well as on the properties along said roads which include residential uses; and

On Tuesday, August 8, 2023, public bids were received for the Borough of Montvale's 2023 Road Improvement Program. Seven (7) contractors submitted bid proposals with the apparent lower bidder as DLS Contracting, Inc. Attached is the bid tabulation summary of the three (3) lowest bidders, itemizing the individual bid proposals.

Our office has reviewed the submitted proposals for mathematical errors and contractor experience. We note the following:

- DLS Contracting, Inc. did not have mathematical errors within their Bid
- J.A. Alexander, Inc. failed to provide a price for Base Bid item #3, Traffic Control Measures and Devices.
- American Asphalt & Trucking LLC had mathematical errors on their Base Bid and Alternate Bid 'B'. Therefore, these errors modified their bid summations.

Based upon our review of the submitted bid proposals, we recommend the award of the project to DLS Contracting, Inc., 36 Montesano Road, Fairfield, NJ 07004 in the total amount of \$709,416.67 for the Base Bid plus Alternate Bids 'A', 'B', 'C', and 'D'. The breakdown is as follows:

Base Bid - Various Roads	\$488,152.02
Alternate Bid 'A' - Additional Roadway Repair Items	\$36,850.00
Alternate Bid 'B' - Montvale Borough Hall Parking Lot Area #1	\$26,055.50



§ 347-12 Failure to construct or maintain sidewalks.

Upon failure of any owner to construct or maintain the sidewalk, curb and gutter as provided for in the preceding section, the Property Maintenance Official [Borough Clerk] or his or her authorized representative shall serve, according to law, a notice upon such owner, lessee or occupant, describing the property affected and the improvement for repairs required and stating the intention of the Borough of Montvale to cause such improvement or repairs to be made within 30 days after service of notice in the event that such owner, lessee or occupant shall fail to do so. **For purposes of this section, the following conditions shall be deemed to constitute a failure to maintain a sidewalk:**

- 1. The presence of three or more cracks on a 3'x3' sidewalk section**
- 2. A height differential greater than 1 inch within a 3'x3' section or between two such sections**
- 3. An uneven surface caused by pitting or spalling of concrete in excess of 25 square inches within a 3'x3' section, or causing a height differential of greater than ½" within a section**
- 4. The protrusion of roots, pipes, or other materials greater than ½" above the surface of the sidewalk**
- 5. Other conditions that in the reasonable discretion of the public officer having jurisdiction create a tripping hazard or a danger to the health, safety or welfare of the public**


The County of Bergen provides the following update on the status of the County's roadway resurfacing program which affects one or more roads within your municipality.

The New Jersey Department of Transportation, Division of Local Aid, provides an annual County Aid grant allotment which funds Bergen County's roadway resurfacing program. Projects utilizing NJDOT funds are required to obtain Division of Local Aid approval prior to advancing to bid. Additionally, due to the engineer's estimate exceeding \$12.5M, an approval of the project plans and specifications by the Office of the State Comptroller is also required. For the resurfacing contract that was originally intended to be performed in 2023, the County has been seeking NJDOT approval to advance to bid since December 2022, and seeking the Office of the State Comptroller approval since February 2023. Unfortunately, to date, these two state agencies have been unable to agree on bid document language in order to advance to the public bidding phase.

The Division of Local Aid and the Office of the State Comptroller will be meeting in the near future to resolve the bid document language. The County is hopeful that this resurfacing contract will be able to advance to bid shortly. However, the delay has prevented the County from advancing the roadway resurfacing program in 2023 and now expects to perform the work in 2024.

The County understands the importance of a well-maintained infrastructure and is making every effort to move the resurfacing program forward. Your patience and understanding is appreciated. The County will provide an update on the resurfacing program status once available.
