



This month we unveiled the concept for a new community center that will have enough space for the senior's club, the scouts, the athletic league and to include an indoor running track with a basketball court. Two outdoor pools also to be built next to the center on Memorial Drive, replacing the current center. There will be a \$10 fee for replacement badges. The Recreation Department has updated the tennis court's magnetic card reader to a proximity reader. 
