The meeting information was posted on the website & Sunshine Law is in effect. Meeting open to the public. There were no members of the public present.

President Cohen asked for a motion to approve the June minutes. M. Danna made a motion to approve the minutes & J.Jacobson seconded it. The minutes were approved on a roll call vote. The minutes will be posted on Borough website.

J. Cohen asked G. Dorsi to read Activity Report and provide updates. There was an open discussion regarding inspections. President Cohen asked how often establishments are inspected. G. Dorsi, stated one annual mandatory inspection is done, swimming pools are inspected twice. If there are any issues, a spot inspection is done immediately. President Cohen asked for clarification regarding a new food delivery service to residential homes from a mobile food truck, **Wonder.** An article will be emailed to members, who are also encouraged to visit the website. G.Dorsi stated food is prepared at an inspected location not within Montvale. Wonder is to be viewed as a food delivery service and does not require a Montvale food license or inspection.

The Annual Flu clinic is scheduled for October 8, 2022 from 9-11AM. .Information is available on the website and Montvale TV Access.

The clinic will be announced at the senior club meeting and Councilwoman T. Cudequest will announce the clinic at the M&C meeting. Members will help with the paperwork and organization.

A tentative date for the rabies clinic is November 8. J. Russo will contact the vet regarding Dr. Cohen's availability. G.Dorsi will check NWBRHC schedule and contact J. Russo tomorrow. J. Russo reminded G. Dorsi to check if the syringes have been ordered.

G.Dorsi said an interim health Officer, Judy Migliaccio will replace the former officer. Montvale health inspector is resigning. G. Dorsi will be the REHS for Montvale until further notice and is hoping to assume that role full time once examination in November is passed.

President Cohen contacted HARP regarding offering a free AED class to t Montvale seniors and residents for the fall. Dates will be determined on the center's availability.

Geese population at the parks this summer has improved.

Mayor contacted President Cohen regarding an inquiry he received about lantern flies. It has been established that the flies are in Bergen County. President Cohen referred the Mayor to the State Environmental Commission for information.

J. Landzberg made a motion that when location and space is available, the Board recommends social distancing to help in COVID prevention. This information will be emailed to Senior Club President. J. Jacobson seconded. All in favor.

NW Bergen Reg. Health Commission Activity Reports G. Dorsi read June, July & August reports. All members were provided with copies. Open discussion regarding items. Northwest Bergen Regional Health Commission may be receiving free Covid testing kits to be distributed to those experiencing financial hardships. Free test kits are occasionally available thru government website. Monkeypox is present in Bergen County, currently there are no registered cases in Montvale.
