AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONTVALE, COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 121 OF THE BOROUGH CODE TO ESTABLISH A RESIDENT PARKING PERMIT PROGRAM IN DESIGNATED AREAS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Montvale as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Chapter 121 of the Code of the Borough of Montvale is hereby amended and supplemented to add a new Article XVI. "Resident Permit Parking." as follows:

Article XVI - RESIDENT PERMIT PARKING

§121-46	Program established; purpose.
§121-47	Permit zones designated.
§121-48	Permit application and issuance.
§121-49	Permit regulations.
§121-50	Enforcement, violations and penalties

§121-46 Program established: purpose.

- A. Establishment of program. The Borough of Montvale finds that parking restrictions that limit on-street parking to neighborhood residents in certain designated areas are necessary and advisable. Therefore, the Borough does hereby establish a Resident Parking Permit Program in the Borough for the streets and areas set forth herein.
- B. Purpose. The purpose of the Resident Parking Permit Program is to:
 - 1. Reduce hazardous traffic conditions within certain residential areas.
 - 2. Protect residents from unreasonable burdens in gaining access to their residences.
 - 3. Promoting efficiency in the maintenance of those streets in a safe and clean condition.

- 4. Ensuring proper vehicular traffic flow.
- 5. Controlling and/or monitoring on-street parking in the Borough in a safe, efficient and non-hazardous manner.

§121-47 Permit zones designated.

A. The following streets or parts of streets are hereby designated as resident parking permit zones:

Zone	Street	Side and Hours	Location
1	Akers Avenue	West	From a point 340 feet north of the centerline of the intersection of Akers Avenue and Grand Avenue, northerly to a point 430 feet south of the intersection of Akers Avenue and Ellsworth Terrace

B. For the zones set forth above, the residents entitled to permits shall be as set forth below:

Zone	Residence location
1 .	Akers Avenue, between Grand Avenue and Ellsworth Terrace

C. It shall be unlawful and a violation of this Article for any person to park any vehicle in a resident parking permit zone without a valid permit issued by the Borough Clerk.

§121-48 Permit application and issuance.

- A. Application.
 - 1. Application for resident parking permits shall be made in writing to the Borough Clerk upon forms approved by the Borough.
 - An applicant for a permit shall show to the Borough Clerk satisfactory evidence that the applicant fulfills all the conditions required for the issuance of such permit.
 - 3. There shall be no fee for a resident parking permit.

B. Violations.

- 1. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Article shall be subject to a fine of \$54.
- 2. In the event that any individual is found to be in possession of an invalid, expired or counterfeit resident parking permit, in addition to the fine set forth herein, said individual and anyone residing at the individual's residence shall surrender any active permits to the Borough Clerk and shall be prohibited from obtaining any resident parking permit for a period of two (2) years.
- 3. In the event that any individual is found to be in possession of a parking permit issued to a vehicle other than the one on which it is displayed, in addition to the fine set forth herein, said individual, anyone residing at the individual's residence, and anyone residing at the residence to which the permit was originally issued, shall be surrender any active permits to the Borough Clerk and shall be prohibited from obtaining any residential parking permit for a period of two (2) years.

Section 2. Severability.

If any provision or portion of a provision of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional, preempted by Federal or State law, or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of the ordinance shall not be invalidated and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Effective date.

This Ordinance shall take effect on October 15, 2017. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Borough Clerk shall be authorized to begin accepting applications and issuing resident parking permits pursuant to this Ordinance immediately after adoption and publication according to law.

Section 4. Repeal of inconsistent ordinances.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

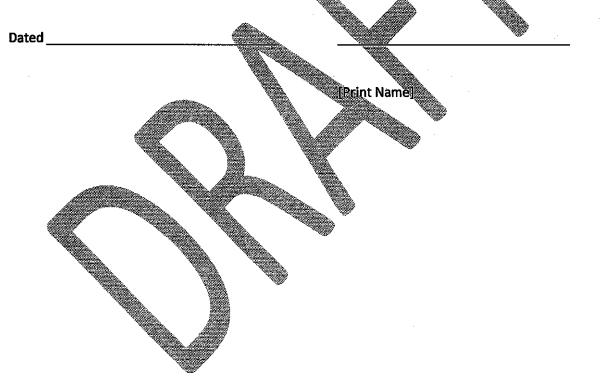

Dear Mayor/Freeholder Director/County Executive:

On behalf of Governor Christie I am pleased to announce that applications will now be accepted for the New Jersey Department of Transportation's (NJDOT) FY 2018 State Aid programs. As Commissioner of Transportation we are committed to maintaining and improving New Jersey's local transportation infrastructure by providing financial assistance to counties and municipalities for traditional and non-traditional transportation initiatives.

The following is a brief description of each program:

- Municipal Aid This program has been a significant resource for municipalities in funding local transportation projects. All municipalities are eligible. The Department continues to encourage municipalities to consider using the Municipal Aid Program to fund projects that support walking and biking in their communities. NJDOT has set a goal to award up to 10% of the Municipal Aid Program funds to projects such as pedestrian safety improvements, bikeways and streetscapes.
- Transit Village This program will award grants for traditional and non-traditional transportation projects that enhance walking, biking and/or transit ridership within 1/2 mile of the transit facility. Only New Jersey municipalities that have been designated as Transit Villages by the Commissioner of Transportation and the inter-agency Transit Village Task Force are eligible to apply. The eligible town list can be found at:

• Bikeways - This program is intended to fund bicycle projects which create new Bike Path Mileage. It is available to all counties and municipalities. The Department continues to work toward the goal of achieving 1,000 miles of dedicated bikeways in New Jersey. Special consideration will be given to bikeways that are physically separated from motorized vehicular traffic by an open space or barrier, but on-road bike lanes and other bike routes and facilities are also eligible for funding.

• Safe Streets to Transit - The intent of this program is to encourage counties and municipalities to construct safe and accessible pedestrian linkages to transit facilities, in order to promote increased usage of transit by all segments of the population.

All projects funded through the Transportation Trust Fund must comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). ADA guidance, program descriptions and application guidance materials can be found on the NJDOT website at:

http://www.state.nj.us/transportation/business/localaid/stateaid.shtm

If you choose to apply, please consider the following in your applications. NJDOT requires grant projects to be awarded to construction within 24 months from the date of grant notification.

I encourage you to submit applications for these Local Aid programs. Each program application will be evaluated independently, affording counties and municipalities the opportunity to receive funding in more than one category.

The enclosed map provides contact information for each Local Aid District Office. Please keep in mind that a separate application for each project must be completed and submitted on or before October 6, 2017 on-line through SAGE at:

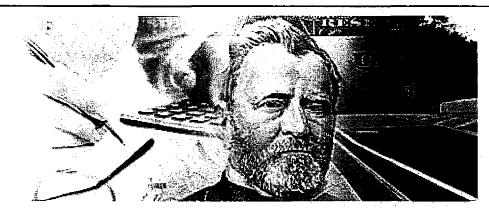

On April 11, 2017 by Resolution 92-2017 (attached), the Mayor & Council awarded the referenced contract to New Prince Concrete, 215 Elleen Terrace, Hackensack, New Jersey. The award in the amount of \$2,064,244.05 did not include the award of either Alternate "A" or "B". At the time, it was determined that there was no support for Alternate "A", which included the installation of sidewalks on Spring Valley Road in Park Ridge.

The award of Alternate "B", the widening of Chestnut Ridge Road in the vicinity of KPMG which is to be funded by the County, was deferred based on the recommendation of the Borough Attorney. At the time of the original contract award, the Borough had not received either the Shared Services Agreement with the County or the County funding, despite repeated assurances that same would be forthcoming. The Borough has now received the County funding, and the Shared Services Agreement requires only minor revisions and will be finalized prior to the execution of the Change Order. At this time, the Borough Engineer and the Borough Attorney recommend that the Borough proceed with this Change Order since this was obtained through competitive bidding and to avoid further delays and inefficiency in the project. As noted, New Prince Construction has already provided a Bid in the amount of \$485,445.54 for this Alternate and is willing to perform the work for that same bid price.

We should note that Change Order No. 1 exceeds the general twenty percent (20%) limitation, and thus compliance with the provisions of N.J.A.C. 5:30-11.9 is required. In consultation with the Borough Attorney, we are providing this explanation as to why believe that the Change Order is authorized under the relevant regulations. Our office recommends the award of Change Order No. 1 for the following reasons, which constitute our certification as to the need for this Change Order:

1. As noted above, the award of Alternate "B" was deferred until the County funding was obtained by the Borough and a Shared Services Agreement was in place. It was purely an administrative delay at the County level that precluded the Borough from awarding

Alternate "B" at the time of the original contract award. The Borough now has the

funding in place and an executed Agreement is forthcoming;

2. The Contractor has already mobilized for the remainder of the County intersection improvements. Should this Change Order not be approved or delayed further, the Contractor may not hold the Bid price requiring that the Borough go out to bid for these improvements separately;

3. The Alternate "B" price provided was the lowest of all five (5) contractors providing bids, and approximately \$32,000 lower than the next highest bidder. An award of Alternate "B" at the time of the original contract award would not have changed the

determination of the lowest responsible and responsive bidder;

4. The widening of Chestnut Ridge Road was included with the County intersection project bid package specifically since it will greatly improve traffic flow in the area. Additionally, if approved at this time, these improvements will be completed in advance of the expansion of the KMPG complex, and the related increase in traffic. In addition, the Borough anticipates the opening of a new Wegmans store on September 24, 2017, which will result in an increase in traffic in the area. Proper coordination of this work, including the immediate performance of the work contemplated by the Change Order, is necessary to promote efficiency and to protect the public safety welfare.

- (a) For 12 months from the date of this Agreement, the CORPORATION warrants that if any part of the System does not work because of a defect or because of ordinary wear and tear, the CORPORATION will repair or replace that part at no charge to the BUYER. The Limited Warranty does not cover batteries, nor does it apply if the System has been damaged by the BUYER, accidents, power surges, misuse, vandalism, lack of proper maintenance, unauthorized changes or acts of God (such as fires, earthquakes, floods, tornadoes, etc.).
- (b) This limited warranty is the only warranty the CORPORATION makes, is made only if the CORPORATION installed the System, and takes the place of all other warranties whether express or implied. NO EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES EXTEND BEYOND THE FACE OF THIS AGREEMENT. <u>LIMITATION ON LAWSUITS; JURY TRIAL</u>. The BUYER must bring any lawsuit against the CORPORATION within 1 year after the act, omission or event occurred upon which the lawsuit is based. <u>PROPOSAL/PURCHASE ORDERS/OTHER AGREEMENTS/CHANGE ORDERS</u>. In the event of any conflict between this Agreement and any other agreement, proposal, contract or purchase order relating the subject matter hereof, the terms of this Agreement shall govern and control.

MISCELLANEOUS. This Agreement contains the entire understanding between the BUYER and the CORPORATION relating to this Agreement and its subject matter, and replaces any earlier discussions or agreements. This Agreement cannot be changed except in writing signed by BUYER and CORPORATION. If any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid, the remaining provisions are still effective.
