Proclamation

A Proclamation Recognizing October 13, 2021 as Metastatic Breast Cancer Awareness Day

WHEREAS, October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month; and

WHEREAS, breast cancer is the most common type of cancer among women in the world, and second leading cause of cancer death among women in the United States. More than one in eight women and one in 833 men in the U.S. will be diagnosed with breast cancer in their lifetimes. In 2021, an estimated 284,200 Americans will be diagnosed with invasive breast cancer, including over 8,330 women in New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Metastatic breast cancer occurs when breast cancer spreads to other parts of the body, including the bones, lungs, liver and brain and has an average life expectancy of 26 months. Regardless of early detection, approximately 30% of stage 0 to III breast cancers will return as stage IV. An estimated 44,130 Americans, including 1,250 New Jerseyans, will die from breast cancer in 2021, equal to 115 women and men per day, with 98% due to metastatic breast cancer; and

WHEREAS, metastatic breast cancer affects all races and socioeconomic classes. While Caucasian women see slightly higher incidence rates of breast cancer, the mortality rate for Black women with breast cancer is 41 percent higher than that of Caucasian women, and breast cancer is the leading cause of cancer-related death for Hispanic women; and

WHEREAS, the metastatic breast cancer awareness tri-color ribbon includes teal, pink and green: The teal color portrays healing and spirituality. Green represents the triumph of spring over winter, life over death, renewal, hope, and immortality and the thin pink overlay signifies that the cancer originated in the breast; and

WHEREAS, there is a national #LightUpMBC campaign on October 13th every year to illuminate 115 landmarks in the metastatic colors of teal, pink and green, throughout the world, bringing awareness to the disease and to honor the daily number of lives lost to MBC.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Borough Council and I, Michael N. Ghassali, Mayor of the Borough of Montvale, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey do hereby recognize and observe October 13, 2021, as **Metastatic Breast Cancer Awareness Day** and encourage all citizens to join the national effort towards awareness of metastatic breast cancer during the month of October, including through efforts such as the **#LightUpMBC** national campaign.

145-2021 Tax Appeal Settlement/Block 908/Lot 8/10 Candlelight Drive/S. Kennis

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Montvale have been advised of the proposed settlement of a property Tax Appeal filed by Scott Kennis (hereinafter the "Tax Appeal"), under Docket Number 007228-2020; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid tax appeal involves a residential property located at 10 Candlelight Drive, and is otherwise referred to as Block 902 Lot 8 on the tax assessment map of the Borough (hereinafter the "Subject Property"); and,

WHEREAS, the said Governing Body has been advised as to the merits of the subject Tax Appeal by legal counsel and the Borough Tax Assessor; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed Tax Appeal settlement would adjust the subject properties' property tax assessment from \$1,083,600 to \$1,073,600 for the 2020 tax year; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 54:51A-8 (the "Freeze Act") are expressly waived for the 2021 tax year; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Borough of Montvale to settle the subject Tax Appeal in accordance with the settlement proposal set forth hereinabove.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Montvale, that the settlement of the aforesaid Tax Appeal is hereby approved; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that with respect to same, the Mayor, Borough Administrator, Tax Appeal Attorney and/or any other appropriate Borough official is hereby authorized to perform any act necessary to effectuate the purposes set forth in this Resolution.

146-2021 A Resolution Declaring an Emergency Affecting Public Health, Safety and Welfare and Awarding an Emergency Contract to Downes Tree Service, Inc. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 and N.J.A.C. 5:34-6.1

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer by letter report dated September 28, 2021, advised the Borough that due to recent weather events including most specifically Hurricane Ida, the Pascack Brook has a large number of trees and other debris within its banks; and

WHEREAS, this debris, some of which collected near the Grand Avenue Bridge, has contributed to localized flooding and would likely exacerbate any additional flooding in the event of another significant rain event and/or cause debris to flow downstream, potentially causing damage to bridges including those at Magnolia Avenue and Grand Avenue; and

WHEREAS, maintaining the Pascack Brook in a manner relatively free from debris is essential to public health and safety of the residents of Montvale, and the present state of the Pascack Brook poses a threat to local residents, roadways, bridges and other structures in the vicinity of the Pascack Brook; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer advised that the condition represents a danger to the health and safety of the general public; and

WHEREAS, based upon the advice of the Borough Engineer, conducting a full public bidding process would delay the execution of the critically necessary clearing and repair by a minimum of six (6) to eight (8) weeks, during which time any significant rainfall event could cause flooding and/or damage to critically-important roadways and bridges; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer did therefore solicit a proposal from Downes Tree Service, Inc. to identify the debris to be removed from the Pascack Brook, restore the streamflow, and transport the materials off-site pursuant to NJDEP guidelines; and

WHEREAS, it has been impracticable to obtain additional quotes due to the inability to get a contractor to spend the hours on-site necessary to walk the stream and produce a quote, likely due to the fact that many contractors in the area are particularly busy with other storm cleanup projects; and

WHEREAS, Downs provided a proposal dated September 14, 2021, to perform the scope of work set forth above, which provides for rates of \$5,850/day for the crew and \$1,800/day for equipment; and

WHEREAS, this work will be conducted on a *per diem* basis, with the work to be performed only that which is necessary to address the scope of the emergency, with an estimated cost of \$60,000; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Borough Engineer that the scope of said contract is intended only to meet the immediate needs of the emergency, and that there is no feasible way to minimize the scope of services for this contract under the circumstances; and

WHEREAS, this emergency situation could not have been reasonably foreseen by the Borough; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the Borough Engineer's September 28, 2021 report, the Borough Administrator is satisfied that the situation constitutes an "imminent emergency" for purposes of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 and N.J.A.C. 5:34-6.1; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council is satisfied based upon the letter report from the Borough Engineer dated September 28, 2021, that the conditions in the Pascack Brook represent a danger to the health and safety of the general public and thus constitute an "imminent emergency" for purposes of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 and N.J.A.C. 5:34-6.1; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council is desirous of awarding a contract to Downes Tree Service, Inc. at the rates set forth in the September 14, 2021 proposal, not to exceed \$60,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Montvale as follows:

- 1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein as if set forth at length.
- 2. The Borough Council hereby declares that the situation at the Pascack Brook constitutes an "imminent emergency" justifying the use of emergency procurement procedures.
- 3. The contract with Downes Tree Service, Inc. as set forth above is hereby awarded, and the Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby directed, authorized and empowered to execute all documents necessary to effectuate the provisions and purposes of this resolution.
- 4. A copy of the September 28, 2021 letter report from the Borough Engineer shall be filed in the minutes along with this resolution.

Introduced by: Councilmember Russo-Vogelsang; seconded by Councilmember Roche – a roll call was taken - all ayes with the exception of Councilmember Lane abstaining.

The borough engineer gave a brief explanation, stating he walked the entire length of the brook with Downes Tree Service to determine which trees were hazardous; FEMA will reimburse 75% of the cost.
