PUBLIC HEARING ORDINANCE NO. 2022-1521 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 84 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONTVALE. COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, IN ORDER TO REVISE THE TABLE OF ORGANIZATION OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Borough of Montvale is in the process of hiring additional police officers to serve and protect the Montvale community, and

WHEREAS, as a result of the overlap of retirements and new hires, and to ensure continued adequate staffing for the Police Department, it is necessary to increase the maximum number of officers permitted in the Table of Organization.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Montvale, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 84 of the Code of the Borough of Montvale is hereby amended and supplemented by adding the underlined text and deleting the [bracketed] text in \$84-1, as follows:

§ 84-1. Creation and composition.

- A. Pursuant to the authority granted by N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118, the Borough of Montvale hereby establishes a Police Department in and for the Borough of Montvale, New Jersey, to consist of the following positions, and the maximum number of individuals assigned to each respective rank, as follows:
 - Chief of Police: one
 - (2) Captain: one
 - (3) Lieutenant: three
 - (4) Sergeant: five
 - (5) Patrol officers: [17] 18. See Subsection C below.

- (6) Class One Special Law Enforcement Officers (SLEO I) who may from time to time be appointed and who shall serve at the pleasure of the governing body for a term not to exceed one-year, which officers shall not be members of the regular police force but shall nevertheless be under the control and supervision of the Chief of Police: as necessary.
- (7) Class Three Special Law Enforcement Officers (SLEO III) who are retired regular police officers and who may from time to time be appointed and shall serve at the pleasure of the governing body for a term not to exceed one-year, which officers shall not be members of the regular police force but shall nevertheless be under the control and supervision of the Chief of Police for use solely as school security officers as detailed in N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.10, et seq.: as necessary.
- B. This Section shall not be construed as establishing any right on the part of any member or members of the Police Department to appointment to any position within the Department, nor shall it be construed as terminating or interrupting any period of service or tenure of any member of the Montvale Police Department. The existence and continuance of any of the above-specified offices and the number of appointees to each such office shall be determined by the governing body as it may, from time to time, in its sole discretion, deem reasonably necessary for the efficient and effective operation of the Department.
- C. In the event that there is an unfilled vacancy in any of the superior officer positions, the maximum number of patrol officers shall be increased by the number of such vacancies. However, in no event shall the maximum number of officers in the Police Department, including the Chief, Captain, Lieutenants, Sergeants and Patrol Officers, but excluding Auxiliary Police Officers and Special Law Enforcement Officers, exceed 28 [26] members.
- D. The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Montvale shall be deemed to be the "appropriate authority" for purposes of the Borough Code and N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118.

Section 2. Ratification of Prior Actions; No Interruption in Service.

The Borough does hereby ratify and reconfirm all prior actions concerning hiring and promotion in the Police Department taken prior to the adoption of this Ordinance. Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed as terminating or interrupting any period of service or tenure of any member of the Montvale Police Department.

Section 3. Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed only to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

Section 4 Savings Clause.

Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed pursuant to this Ordinance, nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 5. Severability.

The various parts, sections and clauses of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, paragraph, section or clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and publication as required by law.

PUBLIC HEARING ORDINANCE NO. 2022-1522 AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONTVALE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 385, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," OF THE BOROUGH CODE TO DESIGNATE TWO NEW "STOP INTERSECTIONS" AND TO PROHIBIT U-TURNS AT SUCH LOCATIONS

WHEREAS, the Borough has been made aware of certain traffic problems in the vicinity of Fox Hill Road, Lark Lane and Wren Way; and

WHEREAS, in order to address such problems, the Borough did authorize Colliers Engineering & Design to study three intersections in the area and to make certain recommendations to enhance driver and pedestrian safety; and

WHEREAS, Colliers did recommend that all three intersections be made "All-Way Stop" intersections and that "No U-Turn" signs be placed at such intersections; and

WHEREAS, as a result of Colliers' recommendations, the Pascack Valley Department of Public Works did install temporary signage at the identified intersections within the Borough of Montvale; and

WHEREAS, Colliers and the Borough's Chief of Police have reviewed the impact of this temporary signage and have determined that the signs have had a positive impact on the slowing of traffic in the affected area; and

WHEREAS, Colliers and the Chief of Police have recommended that the Borough install permanent "Stop" signs as well as "All-Way Stop" and "No U-Turn" signage at the intersections of Fox Hill Road and Lark Lane, and Lark Lane and Wren Way; and

WHEREAS, Colliers and the Chief of Police have further recommended that the Borough request that the Village of Chestnut Ridge authorize the placement of similar signage at the intersection of Fox Hill Road and Wren Way, which is located in New York within the jurisdiction of Chestnut Ridge; and WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council are desirous of adopting the recommendations of Colliers and the

Chief of Police and amending the Borough Code to implement same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Montvale as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 385 of the Borough Code, Section 41, entitled "Schedule VIII – Stop Intersections," shall be amended and supplemented by adding the following locations of stop intersections:

<u>Section 2</u>. Chapter 385 of the Borough Code, Section 50, entitled "Schedule XIV – No U-Turns," is hereby amended and supplemented by adding the following locations where U-Turns are prohibited: §385-50 Schedule XIV – No U-Turns.

Section 7. Installation.

The Borough Administrator (or such person as directed by the Borough Administrator) is hereby directed, authorized and empowered to take all reasonable steps to acquire the necessary signage and to direct the Pascack Valley Department of Public Works to install same at the identified intersections.

Section 8. Recommendation to the Village of Chestnut Ridge.

The Borough Administrator and/or Borough Engineer are hereby directed, authorized and empowered to provide a copy of this Ordinance, as well as all related studies, reports, correspondence and other documents, to the Village of Chestnut Ridge. The Administrator and/or Engineer shall represent that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Montvale formally request that the Village of Chestnut Ridge designate the intersection of Fox Hill Road and Wren Way as an "All-Way Stop" intersection and that U-Turns be further prohibited at such location.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Land Use Law lays out a comprehensive system allowing for and detailing the process in which applicants for development may seek to deviate from these careful and deliberate land use and zoning regulations through the municipal Planning board's review of a variance; and

WHEREAS, consideration of a land use variance is done by local officials, taking into account the variety of circumstances including the proposed deviation's impacts on the goals of the Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law provides municipalities with substantial tools to support the redevelopment of blighted sites, including the creation of site specific redevelopment plans and numerous financial incentives; and

WHEREAS, legislation, A-1294/S-2103, has been introduced that would preempt local control over land use and zoning regulations, allowing certain qualifying office park and retail center properties to be permitted, as of right, to redevelop as a mixed-use development, not requiring a use value; and

WHEREAS, A-1294/S-2103 requires a planning board approve an application for development to convert and eligible property to a mixed-used development unless the application causes "substantial detriment to the public good" and "substantially impair[s] the intent and purposes of the zone plan and zoning ordinance". a vague standard that may be difficult if not impossible to overcome; and

WHEREAS, A-1294/S-2103 may interfere with municipalities implementing alternative visions for the redevelopment of office park and retail center properties, including as industrial sites, parkland, or sites for needed infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, A-1294/S-2103 would interfere with existing and potential Redevelopment Plans that were specifically developed to address office park and retail center properties; and

WHEREAS, A-1294/S-2103 does not take into account conditions such as flooding and future climate risk that may impact the suitability of a site for mixed-use development; and

WHEREAS, this top-down approach, eliminating local land use planning regulations undermines the recognized benefits of municipal land use regulation, without providing the appropriate review for deviation as outlined within the Municipal Land Use Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the governing body of the *Borough of Montvale in* the County of *Bergen* opposes this legislation, and urges our representatives to not advance further A-1294/S-2103; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLED, that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to Senator Holly T. Schepisi and Senators Bob Menendez *and Cory Booker*, Senate President Scutari, Assembly Speaker Coughlin, Governor Murphy, and the League of Municipalities
